2. Make the following changes to Section 01010:

Section 01010 (in its entirety): Throughout the entire section, replace the word “desired” to “required”.

5.11.2.2 Delete: “600 mm” and replace with “1200 mm”.

Section 18 – OPTIONS

Make the following changes to:

OPTION B – Dining Facility Seating Area Design and Furnishings

Delete 5th bullet in its entirety and replace with the following:

- “Divider walls and partitions: Provide a minimum of 60 meters of half-height wall partitions. Laminates or wood to be coordinated with chairs and tables. “

OPTION D – Decommission Existing Airfield Water Tower

In the “GENERAL“ paragraph make the following changes.

After the second sentence, add the following sentence:

Remove the water tower foundation to 1 foot below grade. Remainder of foundation to be abandoned in place. Back fill to grade and seed.”

Section 01010: Add the following new paragraphs:

- 5.9.2.12 “Provide snow guards for the Barracks on roof at the inside and outside knuckle area.”
- 5.9.3.6 “Provide snow guards for the sloped roofs at the Dining Facility.”
- 8.2.6 “All HVAC systems shall have economizer controls.”
- 8.5.6.5.4.1 “Provide a heat recovery system for the Dining Hall-Seating Area HVAC system.”
- 8.5.6.5.5 Dining Facility – Seating Area
- 8.5.6.5.5.1 “Air System Design: The Dining Facility – Seating Areas shall be served by a chilled water/hot water VAV system with reheat. VAV boxes shall be fan-powered type with hot water reheat coils. DDC systems shall provide as a minimum monitoring and control of zone temperature, timed override and local set point. This system shall be zoned by functional requirements, operation schedules, environmental control conditions, and load characteristics. As a minimum, provide a minimum of 10 VAV boxes uniformly distributed throughout the seating area.”
- 8.5.6.5.5.2 “Perimeter Heating Design: The entire perimeter of the Dining Facility – Seating Area shall be heated using finned tube radiant heaters. Each finned tube shall be controlled by a control valve. Radiant heaters shall be controlled using a wall-mounted thermostat(s) for each exposure.”
- 8.5.6.5.5.3 “Ventilation System Design: Outside air shall be delivered to the Dining Facility – Seating Area year round using the building’s VAV air-handling units. Ventilation system shall be in accordance with paragraph 8.4.6.”
- 8.5.6.5.5.4 “CO₂ Reset Strategy: The Dining Hall – Seating Area shall be provided with a CO₂ Reset Strategy.”

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:
